

## **Conservation Effort Research Report**

Your report must include *at least*:

- an introduction paragraph explaining why you chose the issue that you did
- a general description of the issue and its significance
  
- where in the world the issue is prevalent
  - provide specific case studies, if present and appropriate
- what is causing the problem and/or why are humans engaging in the destructive behavior
- what is being done to prevent further destruction or any restoration efforts
- what (if any) legislation, national or international, exists to address the issue
  - how successful the existing legislation has been
  - enforcement authority and penalties
- what social problems/injustices are created by the issue
  - any efforts to remedy the social problems/injustices
- economic impact – positive or negative (or both)
- what organizations are combating the issue – international organizations, governments (federal, state/provincial, local), businesses, charities or other non-profits, religious institutions, etc.
- what the outlook is for the issue
  
- appropriate images (pictures, graphs, tables, charts, etc.) to illustrate the problem and conservation efforts
  
- properly formatted bibliography and cited sources for all images

Your report must be written in proper format including the following:

- ✓ MLA or APA format
- ✓ 10 – 12 pages of text (not including bibliography or any images)

Your paper will be assessed based on:

- ✓ accurate inclusion of each of the above requirements
- ✓ proper formatting
- ✓ spelling and grammar
- ✓ the quality and variety of sources used

*Your paper must be in your own words. Any work that is plagiarized, or suspected of plagiarism, will not receive any credit, and subject to the school's policy on academic dishonesty.*
